Representative Ryan Guillen (D- Rural South Texas) did his best to make sure that all kids in Brooks County had a present under the tree by participating in the Falfurrias Toys for Tots toy drive last weekend while also applauding the progress being made to make sure these children do not lose their health insurance.

When he's not giving toys to the children of House District 31, Guillen is fighting to make sure that they do not lose their health insurance through the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). Congress did not fund CHIP before their deadline, so Texas has been steadily using the last of its funding from the federal government
