SUMMARY

The Routine Airport Maintenance Program (RAMP) matches local government grants up to \$50,000 for basic improvements such as parking lots, fencing, and other airside and landside needs.

DESCRIPTION

The local government match is 50% of actual costs plus any excess of \$100,000 total costs. For more information about this grant and access to other materials, please visit:

EVALUATION & SELECTION

State funding is a \$50,000 match per airport for each fiscal year. The State fiscal year begins September 1st. The local government match is 50% of actual costs plus any excess of \$100,000 total costs. Airside improvements are of first priority before requesting assistance with landside maintenance and improvements.

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES

Cities and counties are eligible.

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

The program includes “lower cost” airside and landside airport improvements. These items can be more than just maintenance and may be new or additional items of work. Examples include:

- 1) Construction of airport entrance roads,
- 2) Pavement of airport public parking lots,
- 3) Installation of security fencing,
- 4) Replacement of rotating beacon.
