ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES

- 1) Non-profit Organizations
- 2) Charitable Organizations
- 3) Local Government Agencies
- 4) Veterans Service Organizations

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

Projects funded under this grant may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1) Homeless support programs, shelter, transitional living/temporary housing, rapid re-housing
- 2) At risk homeless prevention, long-term rental assistance, case management, wrap-around services
- 3) Temporary housing assistance to families of Veterans who are undergoing long-term treatment at a medical facility in Texas
- 4) Home modification, home repair, or weatherization
