SUMMARY

To provide financial assistance to students with financial need who are enrolled in graduate programs in public affairs, public service or public administration.

DESCRIPTION

The Deans of colleges of public affairs, public service and public administration at eligible college or universities may submit applications for two students per year to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board. The recipient is selected by a committee at the Coordinating Board.

No award received through this program may exceed the average statewide amount of tuition and required fees that a resident student enrolled full-time in a graduate degree program would be charged at a general academic teaching institution. The annual award will be determined each year by the selection committee.

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES

Candidates must be Texas Residents, show financial need, be enrolled as graduate students public affairs, public service, or public administration and intend to work in Texas after graduation.

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

- 2) Only public or private, non-profit college or universities may participate in the program (no private, for-profit colleges or universities may participate)
