PRESIDENT VISITS TEXAS FOR SXSW

AUSTIN— Representative Ryan Guillen (District 31-D) welcomes President Obama to Texas upon his visit to Austin. The President delivered a keynote speech on Friday at SXSW and then a speech at the Democratic National Committee fundraiser later that evening.

"I think it's incredibly important for the American people to see the leader of our country interacting with civilians in an open forum. SXSW was been a major attraction for people to visit Texas and I'm glad the president made the trip," Representative Guillen stated.
