REP. GUILLEN DISCUSSES LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES WITH COUNTY JUDGES

Atascosa, Jim Hogg, Live Oak & McMullen County Judges Lay Out Local Priorities



Austin - This week, State Representative Ryan Guillen (D-Rural South Texas) met with the county Judges of Atascosa, Jim Hogg, Live Oak, and McMullen to discuss their priorities for the 85th Legislative Session.

"Input from our local leaders is vital to our work here in the legislature," said Guillen. "The day-to-day challenges that our counties face are best expressed and explained by our county leaders."

Guillen met with County Judge Robert Hurley from Atascosa, Judge Humberto Gonzalez from Jim Hogg, Judge Jim Huff from Live Oak, and Judge Jim Teal from McMullen at the Capitol this week. At the meeting, the group discussed a number of issues including public safety, transportation, and energy, to name a few.

"There are a number of things we're already working on, and others we're starting on as a result of our discussions," explained the Representative.

Guillen met with the four County Judges after they had caucused in Austin with other county judges from around the state as active members of the Texas Association of Counties. Guillen serves ten rural South Texas counties in the Texas House of Representatives, including Atascosa, Brooks, Duval, Jim Hogg, Kenedy, La Salle, Live Oak, McMullen, Starr, and Willacy.
