EVALUATION & SELECTION

Any agency, organization, or concerned party that makes an effort to raise awareness of vehicle theft and burglary are awarded.

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES

Eligible applicants are law enforcement agencies, local prosecutors, judicial agencies, and neighborhood, community, business, and nonprofit organizations for programs designed to reduce the incidence of economic motor vehicle burglary and theft. To be eligible for consideration for funding, a program must be designed to support one of the following ABTPA program categories:

- 1.) Law Enforcement, Detection and Apprehension;
- 2.) Prosecution, Adjudication and Conviction;
- 3.) Prevention, Anti-Theft Devices and Motor vehicle Registration;
- 4.) Reduction of the Sale of Stolen Vehicles or Parts; and
- 5.) Public Awareness, Crime Prevention and Education.
